Entry Requirements

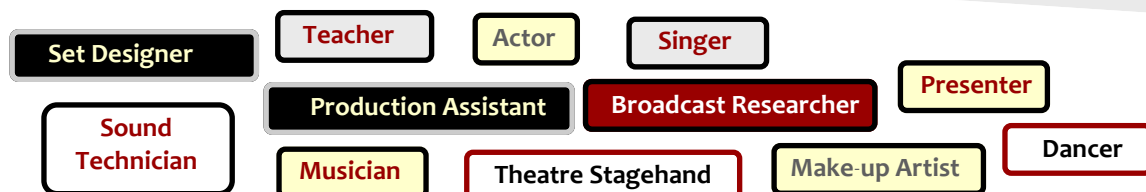
There are no formal requirements for this course, however, a grade C or above in GCSE English Language would be an advantage.

You will engage in a 6 week induction, where attainment during this period will indicate suitability for the course. Commitment to rehearsing is essential.
