


A 2 year course - equivalent to 1 A level

Pearson BTEC Level 3 AAQ National Extended Certificate - Medical Science

Entry Requirements

You should have achieved a grade C or above in GCSE Science or grade CC or above in double award Science or equivalent and a grade C in GCSE Mathematics and English.
