Children should **not** be sent to school if they are displaying any of the following symptoms:

- **a high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- **a new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you have noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

PHW has now also confirmed a wider range of symptoms that are possibly related to Covid-19. These include:

- Feeling unusually tired
- General 'flu-like aches and pains (myalgia)
- Sore throat and / or hoarseness
- Shortness of breath or wheezing
- Persistent headache
- Runny or blocked nose
- Feeling sick (nausea), vomiting or diarrhoea

If one or more of the wider symptoms is present, then a PCR test should be booked.
